# ASEP 2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## STUDENT MARKS CRITERIA

Students should have an aggregate percentage from 10th class to the current year of the course of study as mentioned in the table below. The scholarship will be awarded for the 2023-24 academic year. Marks from 10<sup>th</sup> class through the 2022-23 academic years are considered for selection.

In case student received ASEP scholarship in 2022, only 2022-23 (latest) academic year student marks will be verified.

Example: If a student is studying final year Degree in the Academic year 2023-24 (BSc, B. Com, Engineering, MCA) and received scholarship in 2022, then the student should have 70% in second year of the course or Averages of 70% in first year and second year combined.

- Scholarship applications submitted by students currently studying CA/ICWA/MBA/MCA/Other Master courses in India would be approved by the Executive Committee based on the situation.
- If a student does not meet the marks criteria, the referrer should approach the ASEP regional director with detailed proof to consider them on humanitarian grounds.
- Students currently studying M. Tech, M. Phil, Ph. D, MS & MD are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

## FINANCIAL CRITERIA

Family income (both parents combined income) should not exceed Rs. 3, 00,000.00 (three lakh rupees). Income certificate or white ration card needs to be submitted as income proof (Most recent document).

## STUDENT APPROVAL CRITERIA

1. Receive 40% of the amount from referrer, should be without matching funds.
2. Students should meet marks criteria and financial criteria as explained above.
3. ASEP Team will make random calls to the students/referrer as part of the application process.

The application will be processed after completing the above three-step process and will be sent for Board/Executive Team approval.

In case the application is not approved, the referral amount paid by the referrer will be transferred to ASEP general donation.

## STUDENT APPROVAL CRITERIA – HUMANITARIAN CASES

ASEP Team may recommend a list of ineligible students on humanitarian basis for APTA executive team approval.

In this case the APTA executive team takes a decision based on individual student situation.

This list should not exceed **10%** of the total ASEP approved students.

## FUNDS ESTIMATED FOR 2023 ASEP PROGRAM

Any remaining funds after distributing ASEP 2023 scholarships will be carried forward to ASEP 2024 on discretion of New Treasurer.

## STUDENT REFERRALS CRITERIA

1. Life member can refer up to four students.
2. Patron members can refer up to seven students.
3. Grand Patron Members can refer up to eighteen students.

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED\*

1. Student and Parent consent form with student testimonials regarding APTA and referrer (2 pages)  
**\*\*ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE IN JPG or any Picture Format\*\***
2. Copy of student's bank account passbook first page (1 page)
3. Copy of parent's income certificate or white ration card (1 or 2 pages)
4. Student marks sheets from 10th class to current academic year (2022-23)

The students must submit **all** their marksheets issued by the school/college. If there is a semester system in the course, students must submit the semester marks list,

- Existing students (whoever received scholarships last year) need to submit their latest Marks sheet.
- If there are no total marks mentioned in the marks list, take a copy, write down your calculations, scan & upload.

If the marks list does not have a name, submit the hall ticket. **AADHAR CARD IS NOT REQUIRED**

5. For Students who completed Inter/Degree and applied for Scholarships, they should provide proof of Admission Letter or Fee payment Receipt or Student ID.

## TIMELINES FOR THE 2023 APPLICATIONS

1. First day of application acceptance: July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023
2. Last day of application acceptance: September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023
3. Application review and processing: July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023 – September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023
4. Submitting finalized students list to Executive team and Board: 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.
5. Executive team and Board approvals: First week of October 2023
6. Publishing the finalized list to General Members: Second week of October 2023
7. Planning to Initiate 10 places in India to distribute scholarships during Dasara Holidays in October 2023
8. Cheques arrangements and distribution to students: From First week of November 2023
9. All the cheques should be distributed before Christmas 2023.

**(Planning to distribute the scholarships around THANKSGIVING Time in INDIA)**
