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# ASEP 2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## STUDENT MARKS CRITERIA

Student should have an aggregate percentage of marks per the slabs shown below from 10th class to the current year of the course of study. Scholarships will be awarded for the academic year 2020-21. Marks from 10<sup>th</sup> class through the academic years 2019-20 will be considered for selection.

In case student received ASEP scholarship in 2019 then student marks will be verified for the academic year 2019-20 only.

Example: If the student is studying in the academic year 2020-21 and in case if the student is pursuing 3 years degree course like BSc, B.Com, Engineering, MCA, student should have 70% of average marks in the first and second year combined together and also need to have 80% in Intermediate and 80% in 10th Class.

- \* CA/ICWA/MBA/Any other Master courses – Approval required by the Executive Committee based on the situation.
- \* The students who are currently studying M. Tech, M. Phil, Ph. D, MS & MD are not eligible for this scholarship.

## FINANCIAL CRITERIA

Family income (both parents combined income) should not exceed Rupees 3, 00,000.00 p.a. (Rupees Three Lakhs per annum)

\*Copy of the Income certificate or White ration card to be submitted along with the application.

## STUDENT APPROVAL CRITERIA (TWO STEP PROCESS)

1. Referrer has to pay 45% of the scholarship amount as referral fee.
2. Student should meet marks criteria and financial criteria as explained above.

Once the two-step process is completed, the application will be processed and sent to the Executive Team for approval. Executive team reserves the right for the beneficiary approval process.

**Also, would like to inform that as part of the application process, ASEP Team will make Random referral calls to validate the correctness of the application and documentation.**

In case the application was not approved, then the referral amount paid by the referral will be transferred to ASEP general donation.

## FUNDS & TOTAL APPLICATIONS PROJECTION FOR 2020 ASEP PROGRAM

- **ASEP 2020 Scholarships Target:** 1000 Students OR September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (i.e. the last date of the application acceptance date) whichever happens first.
- **Total funds required (approx. estimation)** - \$250,000 (1000 students \* \$250) (Approx.)
- **Requesting any Balance funds left in ASEP 2019 to be carry forwarded to the ASEP 2020 Funds.**

## STUDENT REFERRALS CRITERIA

Following is the criteria for no.of students that an APTA Registered member can refer based on their Membership status:

1. **Life Member** can refer **up to 3 students**
2. **Patron Member** can refer **up to 5 students**
3. **Grand Patron Member** can refer **up to 15 students**

## SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS NEED TO SUBMIT\*

1. Student and Parent consent form and student testimonials regarding APTA and referrer (1 page)
  - Due to this COVID 19 Pandemic situation, we have **removed the need of a printed version of the application. This process eliminates the need for the students to leave their household to print the papers.**
  - Instead, this year we are asking Student to send us the **Consent form** (Refer page #4 below). This page must be handwritten by student on a white paper and duly signed and then send us a Photo taken from Mobile.
2. Copy of Student's first page in their Bank account passbook (1 page). This is required as the Cheque will be issued on this name.
3. Copy of Parent's income certificate OR copy of white ration card (1 or 2 pages)
4. Student marks sheets from 10th class to the academic year (2019-20)
  - If exams haven't conducted to any class, they have to submit the first semester marks list and they have to submit the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester marks list whenever they receive the same.
  - If there is no total on the marks list, write down your calculations on a piece of paper along with the Marks List. Students need to self-attest the written documents.
5. Students who have passed intermediate need to submit the proof of their college admission after they have joined

- the courses like Degree/ Engineering / Medicine etc.,
6. If the marks list does not have a name, then submit the hall ticket to prove their name on it.
  7. All student's supporting documents (Academic, Financial & etc.,) should be clear and readable **image** formats. Please make sure to take photos in a bright light.
  8. In case student received ASEP scholarship in 2019 then student needs to submit the academic year (2019-2020) marks list & Consent form only.

**\*All documents need to be in image format**

## TIMELINE FOR THE 2020 APPLICATIONS

1. **Guidelines communication to general members: August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020**
2. **First day of application acceptance: September 1, 2020**
3. **Last day of application acceptance: September 30, 2020**
4. **Application review & processing: October 1, 2020 - October 31, 2020**
5. **Finalized students list will be submitted to the Executive team & Board: First week of November**
6. **Executive team & Board approvals: Second week of November**
7. **Publishing the finalized list to General Members: Second week of November**
8. **Cheques arrangements & distribution to students: Third week of November/December onwards**

**\* Timelines may vary based on the Board and Executive Team approvals or the application process.**
